- 1. It has come to the notice of the District Police that a few local businessmen of Shillong City have been served with demand notes from HNLC for an amount of up-to Rs 10 lakhs and that acknowledgement for such payment will be given in the name of some non existing 'Sports Club'. The general public especially business community are reminded that declaration of HNLC as an Unlawful Association has been extended by the Union of India w.e.f 16th November, 2014 and any assistance given to them in cash or in kind will amount to contravention of the Unlawful Activities(Prevention) Act, 1967 and make such donor liable for prosecution under the Act. The District Police request the persons who have got the demand note to come forward and share the information with police and assurance is given that utmost confidentiality will be maintained. On the other hand, if the District Police gets evidence of any person assisting HNLC in cash or in kind, legal action as per law will be taken against such donor.
- 2. Another type of crime has been detected in other states where callers asked for details of insurance policies, lapse policy and other financial details from customers. Though this types of crime has not been reported in the district yet as a preventive measure public are requested not to give their financial details to anyone over phone/mobile but should contact their insurance company/bank before giving any details. This has been issued in public interest.
- 3. In view of the heavy movement of traffic due to Christmas shopping, motorists are requested to comply with all the traffic rules put in place and avoid any parking in 'NO PARKING' Zones. This will help to reduce to traffic jams to a great extent. Entry of all trucks into Shillong city has been prohibited from 9 Am to 9 Pm. However, trucks carrying essential commodities are exempted.
