PRESS RELEASE

1. In connection with the Photograph which appeared in a number of Local and National Dailies where a pole hoisting the CCTV Cameras located at lew Mawlong was shown without cameras and where it was reported that they have been stolen, a clarification is issued herewith:-

On 23.03.2014, a vehicle hit the pole at lew Mawlong and damaged it. The vehicle alongwith driver were caught by police. The pole needed to be replaced and orders were placed from the firm who had earlier supplied. Since it was taking time for the pole to be supplied, all the cameras were removed by Police & kept in safe custody. The camera were never stolen.

Reporters are requested to sought clarification from the undersigned rather than putting up a wrong report.

2. On 07/04/2014, two cases of burglary were reported at NEHU Campus from the houses of Professors. The case was taken up Sub Inspector SI M.Nengnong of Mawlai Police Station and within 24 hours the investigating officer was able to recover the stolen articles and arrest the accused namely Shri Mamang Lenthang, 26 Yrs whose father is a staff of NEHU and also residing at NEHU Campus. During search of his house, stolen articles which include (i) 2(two) Laptops with charger (ii) Gold neckless (iii) 5(five) Gold ear-rings (iv) 1(one) Induction heater (v) 2(two) imitation ear-rings where recovered and seized. During the investigation, it was revealed that he was involved in a number of burglary cases in NEHU and also has a history of drug abuse.
