THE DURBAR MEETING HELD AT POLICE RESERVE, SHILLONG ON 5TH AUGUST, 2017 AT 11.00 AM IN CONNECTION WITH THE WELFARE OF POLICE PERSONNEL OF THE DISTRICT.

The meeting was chaired by Shri Davis N.R. Marak, IPS. Superintendent of Police, East Khasi Hills District, Shillong. At the outset of the meeting, he welcomed all the Police personnel rank and file of the district including the family members of the Police personnel who attended the Police Durbar Meeting. The following agendas were discussed in the Meeting:-

- 1. Cleanliness of Police campus and its surrounding areas.
- 2. Police Welfare related issues.
- 3. Increasing of contribution towards Police Welfare Fund from Rs. 10/- (Rupees ten) to Rs. 20/- (Rupees twenty) per month.
- 4. Quarter allotment and its maintenance.
- 5. Alcoholism and health related issues.
- 6. Discipline of the Police force.
- 7. Any other issues concerned Police welfare.

NEW INITIATIVES: There are many new initiatives are taken up for the welfare of the Police personnel.

- 1. The present drill shed is proposed to be renovated and in that drill shed the sporting activities like Badminton courts, Volley Ball Court, Sports Firing Range is being developed apart from the existing temporary courts. The plan is undertaken to develop into mini stadium with sitting facilities. These are necessitated to de-stress the Police personnel and to encourage them to participate in the sporting activities to keep them physically and mentally fit.
- 2. The district Police has instituted "Best Policeman/ Police Women of the month" award for the Police personnel both AB and UB upto the rank of Inspector. The award will be announced monthly which will carry cash Rs. 2000/- (Rupees two thousand)

- and a certificate of appreciation. The award will be given to one selected Police personnel monthly.
- 3. The construction of recreation hall at the place where the Puja Pandal at Police Reserve, Shillong is underway. The same is expected to be constructed at the end of the year. The plan to this effect is being worked out.
- 4. Construction of Multi-shopping complex with parking facilities are on the plan at Sadar P.S. Complex for the welfare of Police personnel. Plan to set up petrol pump at the premises of Old Officers' Club is underway. The survey have been conducted by the officials and the same is awaited for further approval from the authority.
